Dear Mr. Andrii CHELOMBITKO,

This letter is a response to your letter dated April 29, 2020 on your inquiry about phytosanitary import requirements of Korea on grain from the Ukraine.

I would like to inform you about Korean phytosanitary import requirements for grain of wheat, barley and corn produced in Ukraine as follows :

1. The grain of wheat, barley and corn from Ukraine can be imported by attaching phytosanitary certificate issued by National Plant Protection Organization (NPPO) of exporting country.
2. All consignments should be free from soil, unapproved LMO, leaves or stems host plants of Hessian fly (such as *Hordeum* spp., *Triticum* spp., *Secale* spp., *Agropyron* spp., and *Triticosecale* spp.) and their processed products. Also the grain feed mixed with rice, chaff, straw or the processed products of rice, chaff and straw cannot be imported to Korea from the Ukraine.
3. All consignments should be free from regulated weed seeds.

All consignments arrive in Korea, it should be tested at the port of arrival in Korea according to the Korea Plant protection Act. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me. Finally, please the list of Korean quarantine pests refer to the attachment.
