	<p>II.1 Public health attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian hereby certify, that the poultry meat (1) imported (sent) to the customs territory of Ukraine complies with the following requirements.</p> <p>(a) it comes from (an) establishment(s) approved by the Competent Authority of the EU Member State for supplying their production for intra-EU trade and operating under its supervision;</p> <p>(b) it comes from (an) establishment(s) implementing a programme, based on the HACCP principles in accordance with Ukrainian law on safety and specific quality parameters of food, in particular, the Law of Ukraine "On basic principles and requirements for safety and quality of food products"(№ 771/97) or in compliance with equivalent requirements of Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 (6);</p> <p>(c) it has been produced in compliance with the hygiene requirements, established by the Order of Ministry of Health of Ukraine "On approval of hygiene requirements for the poultry meat and some indicators of its quality» № 694 of 06.08.2013 or in compliance with equivalent requirements of Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 (6);</p> <p>(d) it complies with the Parameters of safety of poultry meat, approved by the Order of Ministry of Health of Ukraine № 695 of 08.06.2013 or in compliance with equivalent requirements of Regulation (EC) No 1881/2006 and Regulation (EC) No 2073/2005 (6);</p> <p>(e) it complies with the Microbiological criteria for establishment indicators of safety of food products, approved by the Order of Ministry of Health of Ukraine № 548 of 19.07.2012 or in compliance with equivalent requirements of Regulation (EC) No 2073/2005 (6);</p> <p>(f) it complies with the guarantees on the absence and/or non-exceeding of the maximum permitted levels of veterinary drugs and contaminants residues under approved national plans for the monitoring of residues of veterinary drugs and contaminants in accordance with legislation of Ukraine or in compliance with equivalent requirements of Directive 96/23/EC (6);</p> <p>(g) it has been found fit for human consumption following ante- and post-mortem inspections;</p> <p>(h) has an identification mark on package or block indicating the number of the slaughter facility or the cutting plant in accordance with Ukrainian law on safety and specific quality parameters of food, in particular, the Law of Ukraine "On basic principles and requirements for safety and quality of food products"(№ 771/97) or in compliance with equivalent requirements of Regulation (EC) No 853/2004 (6)</p> <p>II.2 Animal health attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the poultry meat (1) described in this certificate:</p> <p>II.2.1 was obtained from birds originating from the territory of a country/zone of an EU Member State or Ukraine free from highly pathogenic Avian influenza and Newcastle disease in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code.</p> <p>II.2.2. originated from establishments approved by the competent authority:</p> <p>(a) the approval of which has not been suspended or withdrawn;</p> <p>(b) which, at the time of slaughter, was not subject to any animal health restriction imposed by the competent authority of the country of origin regarding infectious poultry diseases;</p> <p>(c) at which and within a 10 km radius of which (including, where appropriate, the territory of a neighbouring country) there has been no outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza or Newcastle disease for at least the previous 30 days prior to slaughter;</p> <p>II.2.3. has not been in contact at any time during slaughter, cutting, storage or transport with poultry or meat of lower veterinary-sanitary state.</p> <p>II.2.4. has been obtained from poultry coming from establishments:</p> <p>a) which are not restricted regarding any poultry disease,</p> <p>b) at which and within a 10 km radius of which, including, where appropriate, the territory of a neighbouring country, there has been no outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza or Newcastle disease for at least 30 days;</p> <p>II.2.5 have been obtained from poultry:</p> <p>a) that has been kept on the territory of a country/zone referred to in point II.2.1 since hatching or has been imported to such territory as a day-old chicks, as breeding and/or productive poultry or as slaughter poultry.</p> <p>b) has been slaughtered on (2) (dd/mm/yyyy) or between (dd/mm/yyyy) and (dd/mm/yyyy);</p> <p>either (3) (c) has not been vaccinated against avian influenza ;</p> <p>or (3) (c) has been vaccinated against avian influenza using (indicate name and type of used vaccine) at the age of (weeks) (4).</p> <p>d) has not been slaughtered under any animal-health scheme for the control or eradication of poultry diseases;</p> <p>e) during any time of transportation to the slaughterhouse, did not come into contact with poultry infected with highly pathogenic avian influenza or Newcastle disease;</p> <p>f) In case of poultry vaccinated against Newcastle disease, only the vaccines officially approved (registered) by the competent authority of the country of origin were used.</p> <p>II.3. Animal welfare attestation</p> <p>I, the undersigned official veterinarian, hereby certify, that the poultry meat described in Part I of this certificate derives from animals which have been handled in the slaughterhouse before and at the time of slaughter or killing in accordance with the relevant provisions of legislation on animal welfare of the exporting country.</p>
